In the spirit of supporting local, independent restaurants, no group with more than six locations in the Hampton Roads Metropolitan Statistical Area are allowed to apply.
Restaurants must be open to the public during regular, posted business hours and offer cuisine from a published menu.	An application fee of \$125, payable in the form of a gift certificate, is required.
